Alice in Wonderland by Same Difference Arts

The show is approximately 45 minutes long



1. We begin by meeting 3 actors who introduce the story of Alice in Wonderland.



2. The actors go through all the loud sounds in the show, as well as who is playing what character, as they playfully fight it out to be Alice.



3. The story begins with Alice and her Sister Lucy in a pink shirt. They do not really get on, and Lucy is trying to help Alice but she is distracted by a white rabbit that pops up.



4. Alice follows the rabbit and goes down the rabbit hole. She turns into a small puppet and falls down the hole. She sees a teapot and a clock as she falls down.



5. When she gets to the bottom of the rabbit hole, Alice finds the mock turtle and loads of doors. Alice thinks she can get through a door and find the rabbit. But she is too big. She tries a suspicious drink and shrinks down, but the door is locked.



6. Unable to get through she sees a cake and can't resist but eating it.



7. Alice grows enormous, and needs to shrink back down to get into the door. She drinks the shrinking potion, with the help of the turtle and shrinks back down, whilst finding a key.





8. In the next scene Alice finds the white rabbit – who is late for an important date with the Queen. Alice must help the rabbit find his gloves – but the Dodo has hidden the rabbits house keys.



9. The dodo is tempted back to give the rabbit the key, but only in exchange for a jammy dodger.



10. In the next scene, Alice meets the Cheshire cat who is a smooth talking feline. He loves to play with his chocolate balls, but has lost one of them. Alice helps him find it.



11. Once they have found all the balls, the cat encourages Alice to continue on her journey through Wonderland, telling her where to go next.



12. In the next scene, Alice meets a strange Caterpillar. She is a bit scared of them, but learns to think differently about the world around her. The caterpillar turns into a butterfly and shows Alice, its ok to grow and change.



13. Alice then ends up at the Mad Hatters tea party. There she meets a Hare and The Hatter.



14. They have fun playing games like Musical Statues and singing fun songs. Alice is given a special jacket to give her courage to face the red queen.



15. The hare takes Alice to find the Queen while the hatter sings us his special song.



16. Alice ends up at the palace and meets a playing card who is painting the roses red. They are very frantic and scared of the red queen.



17. Suddenly the white rabbit appears and Alice has to help them finish setting up before the queen arrives. They need to find a King from the audience.



18. When the queen arrives she wants to play croquet and invites Alice to play with her. The queen is very mean to the white rabbit.



19. The queen enjoys talking to her king, who has been selected from the audience.



20. The croquet ball that Alice hits goes into the Queen's mouth, and she is very angry.

21. The Queen has a trial for Alice to decide if she will lose her head.



22. The Judge listens to both sides of the story and the audience have to vote to if Alice gets to keep her head or not.



23. Alice wins the trial, and realises she has grown in confidence standing up for herself in-front of the Queen and has learnt so much about herself in her time in Wonderland.

24. Alice wakes up and sees her sister Lucy and tells her all about her time in Wonderland.



25. The narrators come back on, hungry for a jammy dodger, but it turns out Richard has eaten them all during the show! The End.
